The number of abortions in Ohio increased 7% from 2020 to 2021 – with 21,813 unborn lives terminated in 2021 – and despite the overturn of Roe v. Wade, abortion is once again legal in our state through 22 weeks. A LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

During a time in my life, when I was coming out of a negative situation, I clung to Philippians 3:13-14.

"But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus."

Interestingly, at the same time, a man in my church transitioned to Heaven. As I prayed for his young widow, the same verse kept popping into my mind. I remember talking to the Lord about it. Surely, He did not intend for her to forget the happy years she had been married. The more I prayed about it, the more I realized that even though she had been happily married, she still had to move forward. The Lord had called him home, but He still had plans for her life.

I have been thinking about that time in my life lately...remembering what the Lord has done for me and for that young widow. He has been so faithful. The older I get the more I have to remind myself that change, though sometimes uncomfortable, is necessary – especially in pregnancy care ministry. **The most precious asset we have is truth. Our goal has been, and will continue to be, sharing the truth about abortion.** The truth about abortion has not changed but our clients have changed.

Last summer, we celebrated 40 years of ministry. In those 40 years, we have ministered to three generations – Gen X, Millennials, and Gen Z. And this year the oldest of Generation Alpha turns 13. Which means **we have to start preparing to reach a fourth generation.** We have to constantly be striving toward what is ahead.

In the fall of 2021, our Board of Directors developed a three-year strategic plan. This plan had three key components: Evaluate, Establish, and Expand.

We are in the final stages of Evaluation. Over the past several months, we have done a deep dive to evaluate the mission excellence of every aspect of our ministry. We are now reviewing all of that information to move into our next phase, Establish.

In the Establish phase, we will be refining

existing programs and processes to ensure that we have the most effective and efficient systems in place to reach our target audience and provide them excellent services.

The final phase of our plan is to Expand. In this phase of the plan, we will be looking at what new things we need to do to reach more people with the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the truth about abortion.

This plan ensures that we continue pressing forward to the goal which is that every person in the greater Miami Valley will experience gospel transformation that empowers them to choose life for their unborn children and God's design for sexual purity.

OUR LOVE AND CONGRATULATIONS FOR NANETTE'S RETIREMENT

Listening to a radio program changed the course of Nanette's life.

Over 30 years ago, Nanette Gresham was sitting

at her kitchen table listening to a live broadcast on WFCJ from Focus on the Family. That particular day, they were dramatizing "Tilly" – a story about a woman who experiences God's forgiveness after a dream about meeting her aborted baby in Heaven. Nanette said, "The Lord hit me that day that I am post-abortive." Unbeknownst to her at the time, this was also when God placed a very specific call on her life.

She contacted Focus and spoke with Sydna Masse', author of *Her Choice to Heal*, and Nanette made the choice to heal from her abortion decision. She went through the stages of grief,

dug deep into God's Word, and got involved in pro-life work. In 1994, she began volunteering at New Beginnings Women's Center in Huber Heights, which a few years later became a satellite of Miami Valley Women's Center. The policy of MVWC is those who desire to volunteer in Abortion Recovery Ministry (ARM) but have abortion in their past must go through the ARM program. Nanette did, and **God by His grace helped Nanette release anger and shame and fully embrace her identity in Christ.**

After volunteering for over ten years in a variety of roles, including ARM, Nanette accepted the staff position of Abortion Recovery Coordinator in 2007. In 2008, she took over DREAM – a sexual integrity curriculum called *Dare To Realize Every Action Matters* – and also brought that program to women's recovery centers for five years. In 2012, she added Prison Ministry to her title – and has helped bring hope and God's truth to countless female prisoners at the Dayton Correctional Institution over the last ten years.

Obeying God's call on her life, Nanette has led hundreds of women (and couples) to find healing. Some of them had a recent abortion, others 30 to 40 years in their past. Many heard the gospel and responded – one was sitting on her bed at home and texted Nanette to say, "Everything you ever told me about Jesus is true!" Serving in this role has often been hard and emotional, but Nanette shared, "There is nothing like seeing God move – and the power of the gospel transforming lives – and a woman's countenance changing from shame-filled and guilt-ridden to free from shame and self-condemnation, experiencing God's love and forgiveness!" Nanette's life verse has been Romans 8:1 – "There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus..."

REACHING AND SERVING MORE DADS

God has brought an amazing opportunity to our men's program, which has enabled us to make an invitation to the local church!

We were selected by Care Net, the national pregnancy center network Hope Rising is affiliated with, to receive up to a \$20,000 (needs-based) grant! Called "Fatherhood Project 2023", the grant fosters collaboration between local churches and pregnancy centers to help fathers embrace their God-given, irreplaceable role in the family. Care Net's vision is to see a culture where women and men faced with pregnancy decisions are transformed by the Gospel of Jesus Christ and empowered to choose life for their unborn children and abundant life for their families.

Two key resources for the project are a new online course called Doctor Dad, and a church equipping guide called Making Life Disciples (MLD) 2.0. Collaboration between the local church and Hope Rising can take many forms: encouraging men whose wives or partners are pregnant to take Doctor Dad, co-hosting a barbecue or other celebration for fathers who complete a parenting program, and the potential for Hope Rising to refer interested program clients to the church for discipleship.
