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Induced Abortion Summary

Background

The 2023 Annual Abortion Report presents information derived from both the “Confidential Abortion Report” and “Post Abortion Care Report for Complications” in Ohio (see Appendices I and II). Readers should note that abortion statistics in this report are limited to terminations occurring in Ohio; they do not include Ohio residents who obtained abortions outside the state.

Characteristics of Induced Abortions Reported in Ohio, 2023

Induced abortion statistics have been prepared in Ohio since 1976. Several trend comparisons in the 2023 Annual Abortion Report date back to 2004. A total of 22,000 induced pregnancy terminations were reported in Ohio for 2023, including 19,229 obtained by Ohio resident women (87%). This represents a 19% increase in induced pregnancy terminations from 2022 to 2023.

Approximately 8.8% of women who obtained abortions in 2023 were under 20 years of age, with another 28.9% between the ages of 20-24 years of age (Table 1). Approximately 81.7% of women who obtained abortions in Ohio were never married, divorced, or widowed (Table 1). Approximately 12.1% of women who obtained abortions in Ohio were married or separated (Table 1). Of all resident women who obtained abortions and for whom race was reported, approximately 49.8% were Black; 42.2% were White; 3.0% were Asian/Pacific Islander; and 4.7% reported more than one race (Figure 2). 7.4% of women with known ethnicity who obtained abortions in Ohio were of Hispanic origin (Table 1).

The 2023 Ohio abortion rate was 8.7 per 1,000 resident women ages 15-44 years old, an increase from the 7.8 rate in 2022 (Figure 4). The 2023 Ohio resident abortion ratio was 151 abortions per 1,000 live births, an increase from the 134 ratio in 2022 (Figure 4).

More than half of all induced abortions in 2023 involved pregnancies of less than nine weeks (60.8%), with approximately 25.9% involving pregnancies of nine to 12 weeks (Table 1). There were 476 abortions in 2023 involving pregnancies of 19 or more completed weeks of gestation (Table 2). That represents an increase from the 342 reported in 2022. The abortion reporting form requests methods used to determine gestational age: ultrasound was used in 95.8% of cases (Table 8b). The vast majority of reported abortions were obtained in six major metropolitan areas of Ohio (Table 6).

Curettage was the most used method of pregnancy termination in 2023 (45.7%) (Table 7). That method has decreased since 2001 when 87% of terminations were by curettage. Mifepristone was reported as the medication for nonsurgical termination for 9,874 abortions, followed by 4,594 terminations using Misoprostol, and 13 terminations using Methotrexate (Table 7).

Figure 1. Resident Induced Abortions, Ohio, 1976–2023

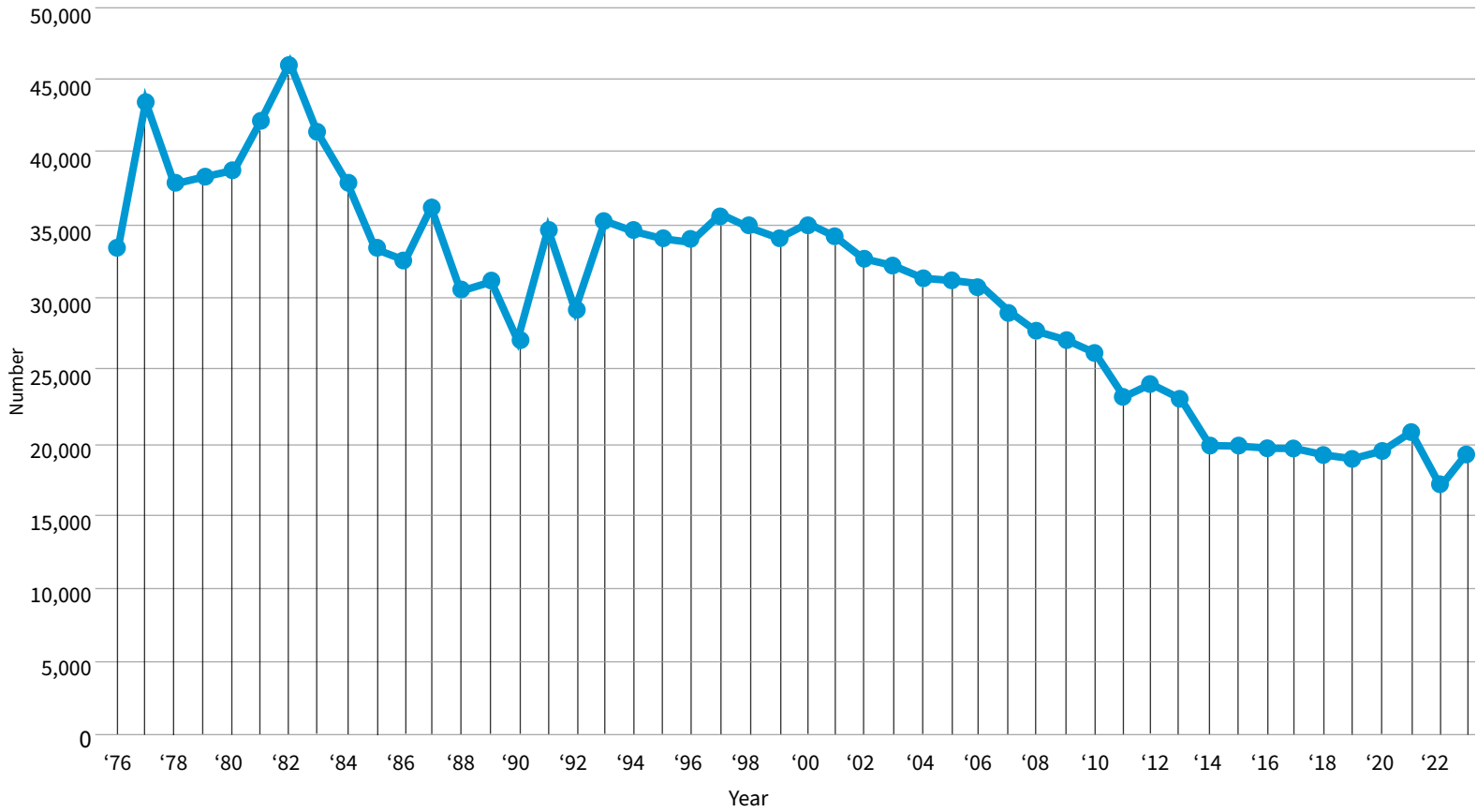
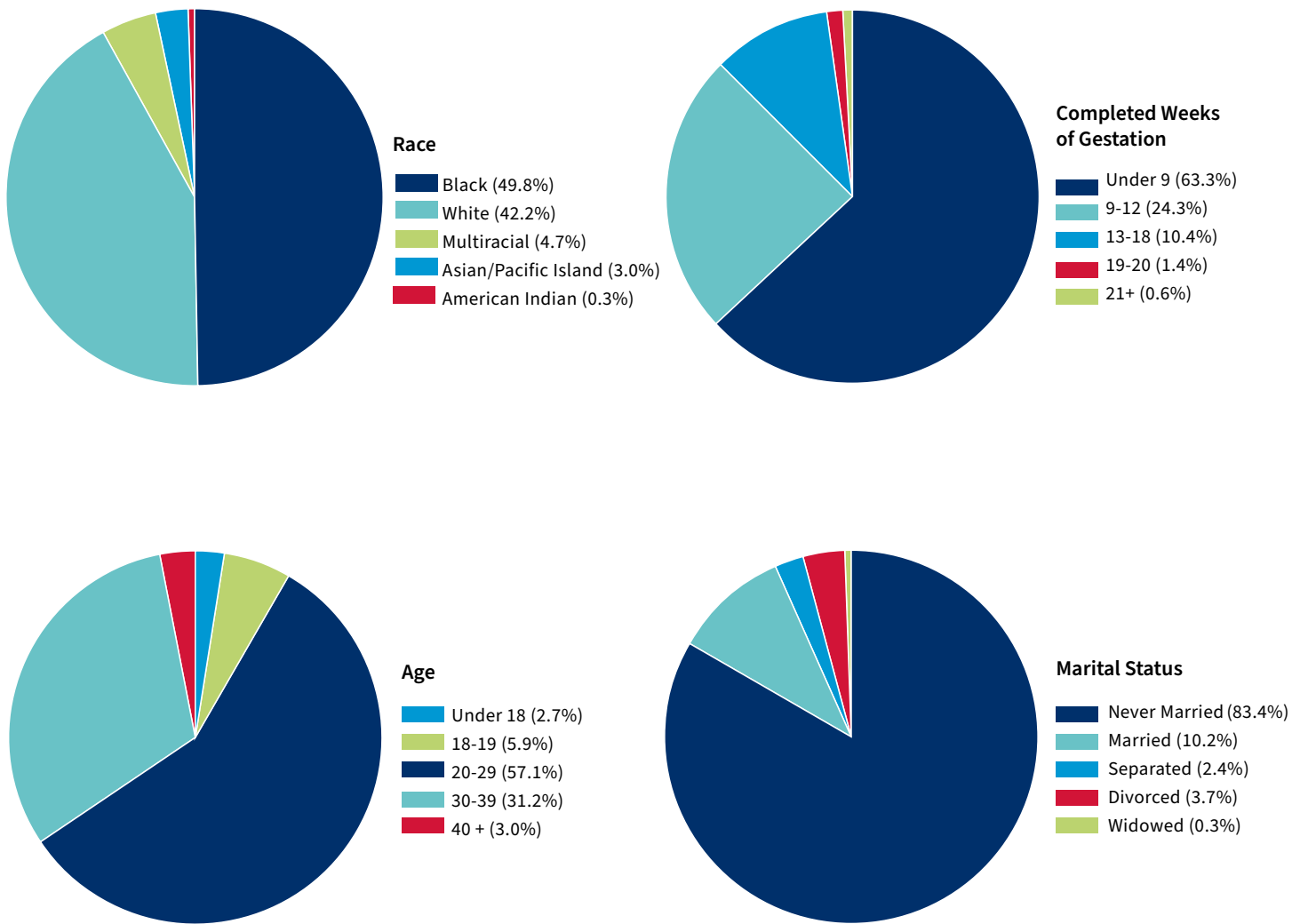


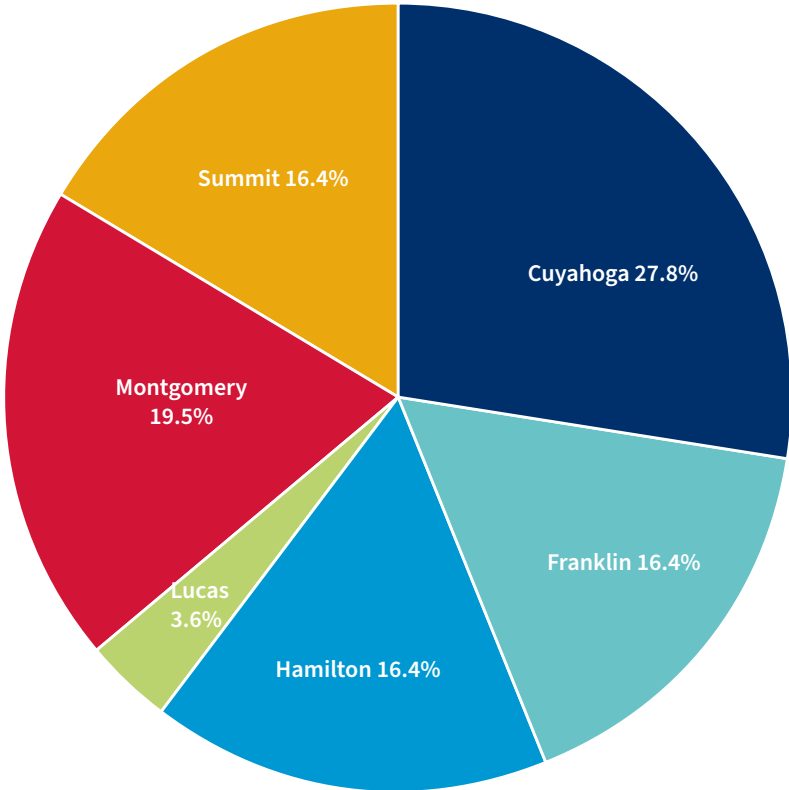

Figure 2. Selected Characteristics of Resident Induced Abortions in Ohio, 2023



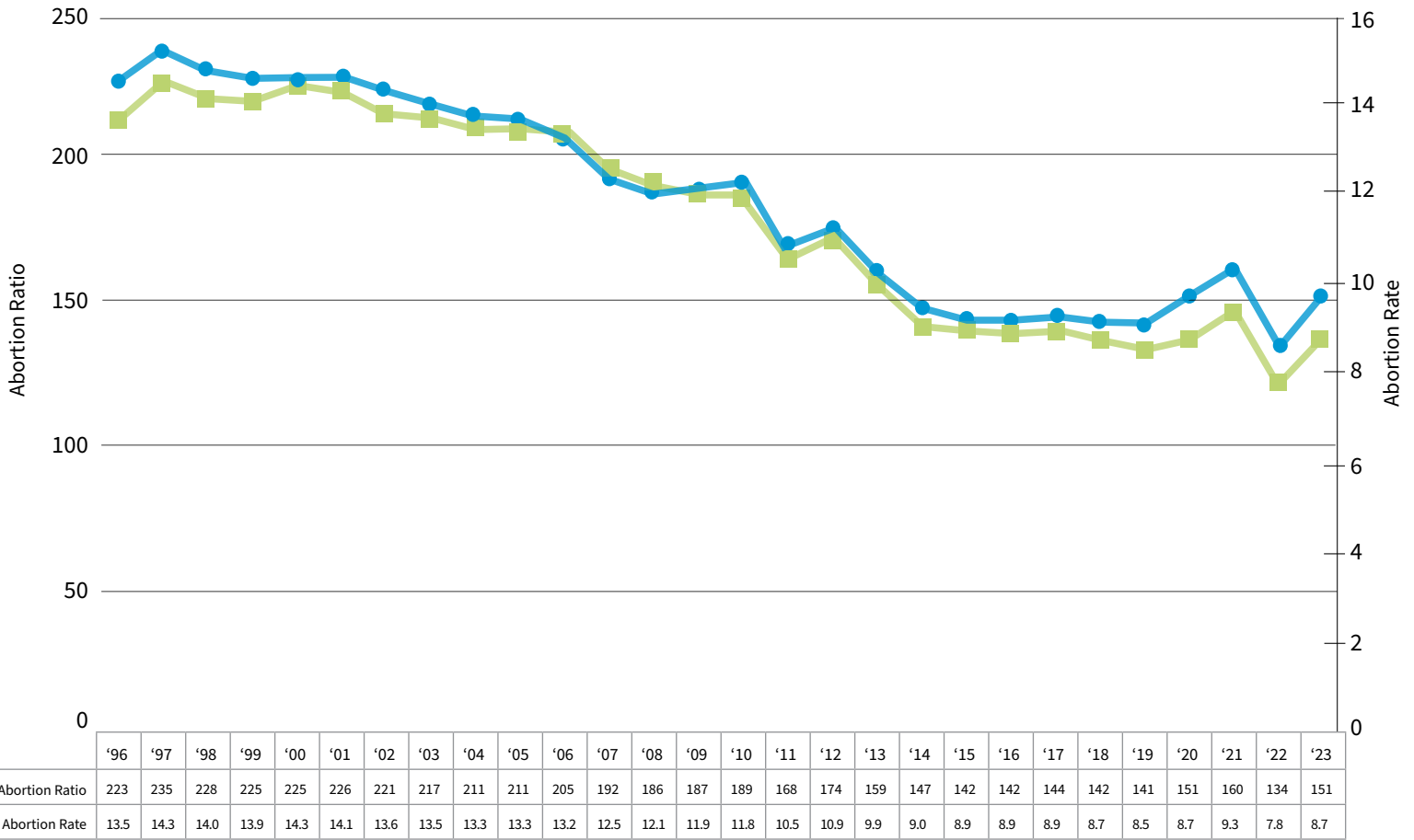

Figure 3. Induced Abortions Reported in Ohio, by County of Occurrence, 2023



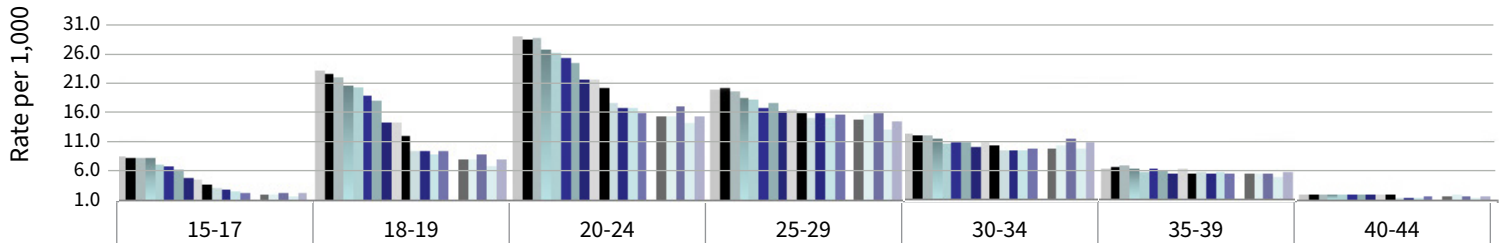

Figure 6. Induced Abortion Ratios, by Age Group and Year, Ohio Residents, 2004-2023

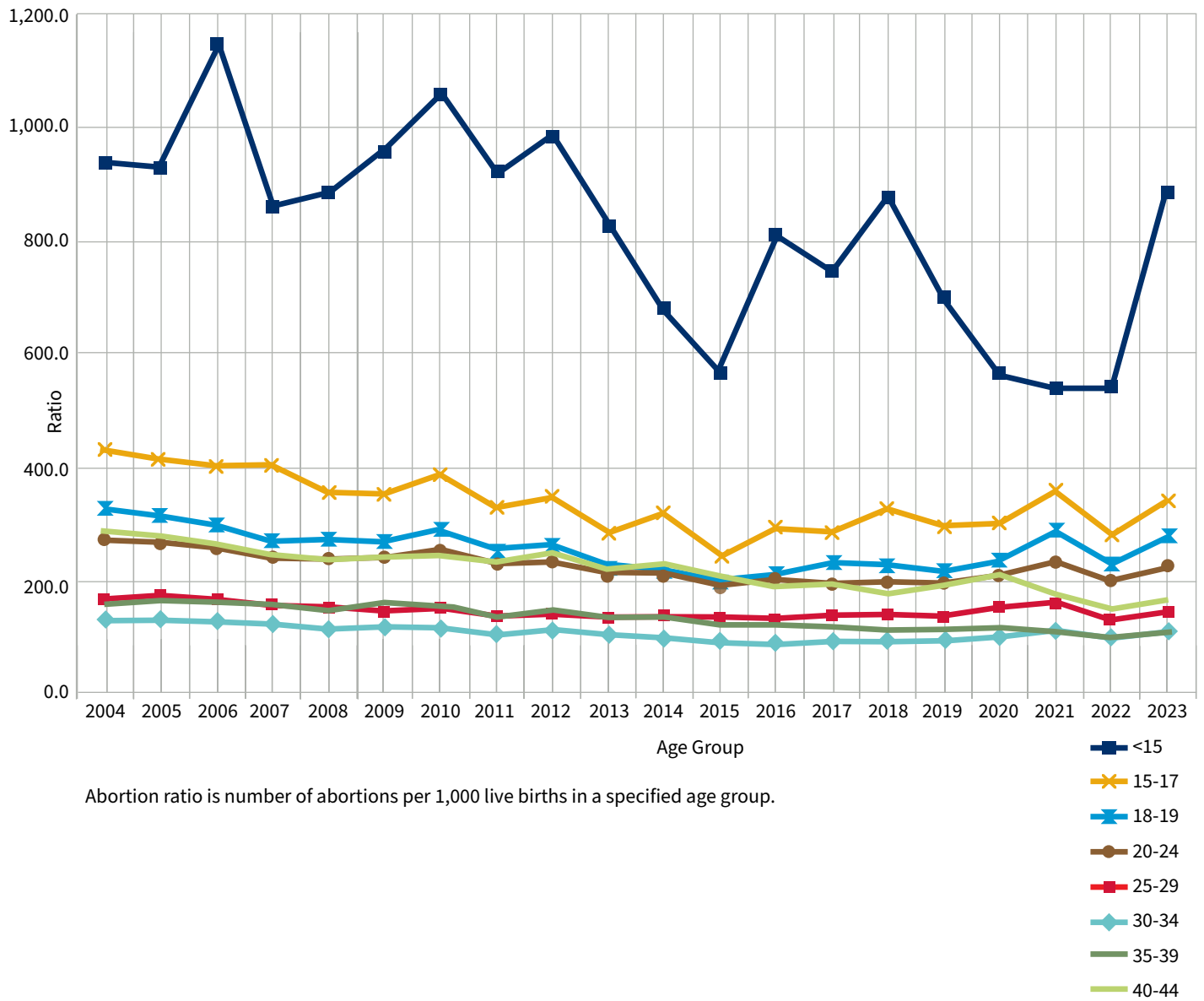
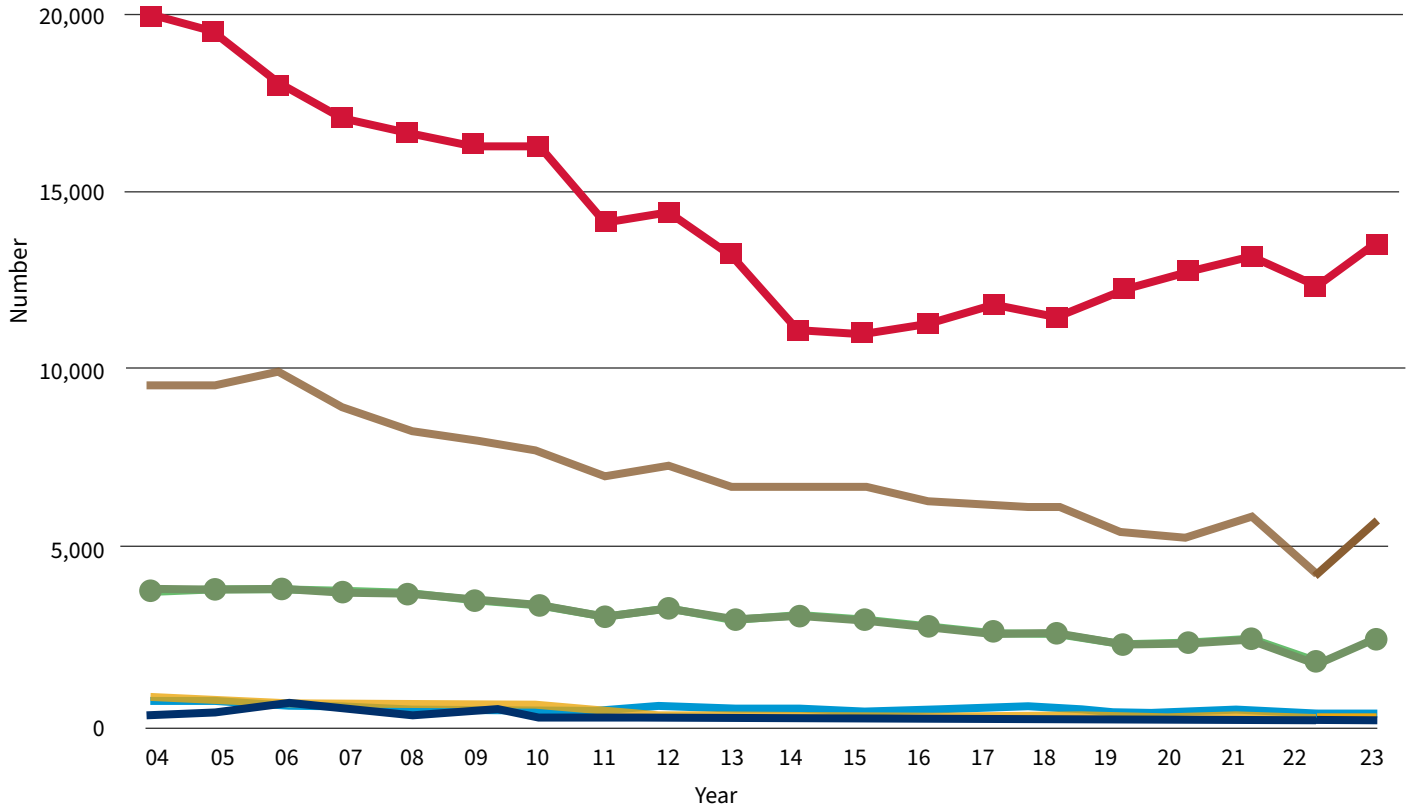


Figure 7. Total Induced Abortions, by Weeks of Gestation and by Year, 2004-2023
